

Salmo Trutta - The Sea Trout

Atlantic Salmon

- 1. The Salmon's eye extends no further than the mouth
- 2. There are few markings below the fishes lateral line
- 3. The tail of a Salmon in concave
- 4. The Salmon has a narrow tail base with a noticable wrist

Sea Trout

- 1a. The Sea Trout's eye extends further than its mouth
- 2a. Larger number of markings below lateral line
- 3a. The Tail of a Sea Trout will be Square, even convex (Immature Sea Trout may have a concave tail.
- 4a. The tail base is wide, with no noticable wrist.

Do not rely on a single feature for identification, you should compare them all
